- 2. What do you know about the Biblical understanding of the heart?
- 3. Why is it important we trust the LORD with all our hearts?
- 4. In what ways can our understanding be flawed?
- 5. What does it mean to really "know" someone?
- 6. In verse 6, in the NIV, we find the word 'acknowledge' ('submit' in the latest revision of the translation). Other translations use different words. What is this word trying to communicate about God?
- 7. In what ways does God make a straight path for us?
- 8. In what area of your life are you finding it hard to trust in God at the moment?

Witness: What would you say to someone to try and instil in them confidence in the trustworthiness of the Bible?
